Pupil Device Scheme

We operate a Pupil Device Scheme (compulsory for Year 7 and Year 4) whereby parents pay a termly fee and the School provides a laptop that is insured and fully compatible with the School network and which will be used across the curriculum. The current cost is c.£85+VAT a term. The exact specification and termly cost for the laptop will be notified prior to the start of the academic year.

Pupils supported by the Head of Individual Learning

Some pupils will benefit from specialist help outside the curriculum with one-to-one lessons and shared and small group lessons in literacy and maths and assistance with study skills across all subjects. Additionally, some pupils require assessment for GCSE suitability. Charges may have to be applied for some or all of the above.

Insurance

There is a fees refund scheme to cover absence from school due to sickness⁴. AXA Healthcare medical cover is also available. Details can be obtained from the School Accountant.

There is a Private Medical Insurance provided by AXA PPP. The cost of which is variable.

Fees (Refer to Parent Contract)

- Fees are due in full on or before the first day of term.
- If payment is not received by the due date, we may charge interest on the overdue amount at a rate of 4% above the base rate of the School bank.
- Legal costs incurred in the recovery of fees will be added to accounts.
- The recognised method of recovery of fees is through a free monthly direct debit scheme administered for the School through a provider. For direct debit customers the termly invoice is for information only. Alternatively, fees should be paid via the school's bank account. Please contact the School Accountant.
- The Governors will endeavour to give at least one term's notice of a rise in fees. They reserve a right however, to impose a surcharge at any time in the event of a sudden and unpredictable rise in school running costs.
- The Governors may request the withdrawal of a pupil if fees invoices are not paid on time.
- A half term's notice, to take effect at the end of a term, is required in writing to discontinue any optional extras under contract.
- It is expected that optional trips, clubs, and social events will be paid in full through Parentmail.
- Childcare vouchers will be accepted to credit fee accounts for early years' children and any other eligible charges.
- A charge of £20 will be added to accounts for any cheque returned to drawer.
- £80 of the entry deposit will be allocated to the Westwoodians Alumni funds, which can be re-credited to a parent on request when a pupil leaves the School.

Leaving

It is a condition of entry to the School that a full term's notice, or a term's fees in lieu of notice, must be given by parents or guardians before a pupil is withdrawn for whatever reason or rescind the acceptance of a place offered to a pupil. This notice must be received by the Headmaster in writing, on or before the first day of term.
